History of the Burgee



A “**Burgee**” is a flag, usually small and triangular, but can be any shape, and used today as a symbol of a yacht club or sailing organization, like Fleet 4.

The history of burgees began in the nineteenth century when ship-owners custom-designed their own “private signal” that generally flew from top of the ship’s tallest mast. These were unique to every ship so that a ship could be recalled to land by a corresponding flag signal ashore.

The first yachting burgee probably harkens back to 1875 when privately-owned boats of the North German Regatta Club flew a club flag not so much for loyalty but to draw a customs exemption from the vigilant officials at the Port of Hamburg. (Coronado Historical Association)

The Fleet 4 burgee is also unique. It incorporates our name very cleverly. Members can purchase a burgee when they join for a discounted price of \$20. You can also purchase additional burgees for \$25. See Gary Preston if you need a new burgee. I encourage everyone to be proud of Fleet 4 and fly your burgee when sailing. On club cruises, you receive points for flying your burgee!

The fee for a slip at the marina is \$31.00 a night with a one-time \$10-\$20 launch fee. (For reserving a slip, email lakehavasumarina@gmail.com). There is a Holiday Inn close by if people don't want to sleep on their boat (1-888-Holiday or Google "Lake Havasu Holiday Inn" to find their web page). The marina does not have showers, so keep this in mind. If we want to boat camp, I'm told that people from BLM may come by and charge \$20.00 a night to camp on the lake. There is a Safeway by the marina for restocking of food/drinks, etc. The average water temp for the lake in March is in the 60's, and air temp is in the high 70's to low 80's! I'm told this is a great lake for sailing and it's sure to be a lot of fun!

For the new to sailing people that might want to go, we have some experienced sailors that can sail with you during the day and have their own places to sleep at night! It can be a great way to become a better skipper by learning from someone who has been on a boat or two in their days! Don't let the fact that you're new to sailing stop you! Tis the season to do the spit & polish on the boats. Lube or service your winches, wash your lines, and check all fittings. Pump your bilges and change your fuel out for fresh. The winter will be gone before you know it, and for those that are going to race, it's time to get away from the TV and ready for the 4 events/5 days that will make up the 2020 racing season for Catalina Fleet 4.

Be advised that there are 2 different classes of racers. There is the Experienced C22 Racers (we know who you are) and the Cruising or less experienced racers. Additionally, cruiser class boats are usually set up for cruising with solar panels, stoves, roller furling, or other amenities that add comfort or practicality.

The 4 events that have been chosen are the final Folsom Lake Yacht Club winter series race number four (4), the TRANS-FOLSOM regatta, the CAMELIA CUP regatta which is 2 days long, and the 1st Race of the FLYC summer series. In case you haven't noticed, all races piggyback on FLYC events. All races have been scheduled early in the year to maximize the probability of both wind and water. The dates follow:

Minutes of Officers' Meeting January 31, 2020

The meeting was called to order at 8:10 by past-Captain Monte Whitefield who immediately passed the "helm" to newly-elected Captain Kevin Clancy.

We planned the times and themes of the Fleet meetings:

- February 13, 7 p.m. (come to eat at 6:30), Round Table at Greenback/Madison, racing rules;
- April 9, 7 p.m. (come to eat at 6:30), Round Table at Greenback/Madison, how-to workshop on knot tying and splicing, we plan to have the rosters available at this meeting;
- ~~June 11~~ [changed to June 5], at the Rayfuse home, 6 p.m., BBQ/picnic;
- August 13, at the Rayfuse home, 7 p.m., ice cream social;
- October 8, 7 p.m. (come to eat at 6:30), Round Table at Greenback/Madison, theme TBD;
- November 7, 6:30 p.m., Banquet and award presentations.

We planned Fleet cruising for:

- February 15 – 17, Monterey whale watching (January got postponed due to weather, etc.);

- March 21 – 22, First of Spring at Folsom Lake;
 - March 22 – 27, Lake Havasu;
 - April 24 – 26, Lake Oroville;
 - May 23 – 25, Memorial Day at Folsom Lake;
 - June 20, Bigs and Littles;
 - July 3 – 5, Independence Day at Folsom Lake or San Francisco Bay;
 - August 14 – 16, Union Valley Reservoir;
 - September 25 – 27, New Malones Reservoir;
 - October 24, Halloween cruise at Folsom Lake.
- All cruises, save the Halloween cruise, count for points toward this year's cruise points; the Halloween cruise will count toward 2021 points.

The Fleet racing program piggybacks on Folsom Lake Yacht Club races:

- the last winter race, March 21;
- Trans-Folsom race, March 28;
- Camellia Cup, April 4 – 5 (both days), count for race points.

We intend to have Fleet rosters ready to hand out at the April meeting. Roy Moore will prepare the draft, Bill Martin and Mike Rayfuse will help with proof-reading and editing. We will have them printed at Kinko's or pay Roy for his costs on a per-page basis.

Roy Moore will try to work with Laura-Ann Charlott on taking over the web-site maintenance. Roy needs the password, etc.

Monte Whitefield will continue his talented recruitment efforts. (We may still have some advertising material on our computers that may be helpful.) We may approach Aquatic Center, Brown's Ravine, etc. for help with hand-outs, etc.

We then discussed the 2020 budget in due-diligence detail, then made changes to the draft prepared by Gary Preston, and approved the modified version.

We adjourned by standing ovation at 10:05 p.m.

Here are the Fleet 4 financials for 2019. We had a Net Income of \$26, with Total Revenue of \$1,993, and Total Expenses of \$1,967.

As a non-profit organization, we budget for zero net income, but of course real-world variances occur. Our Dues cover the costs of Membership,

Communication, Picnics, Meeting Food, Trophies and Miscellaneous Expenses. The Banquet is essentially self-funding, with its revenue covering expenses. After a loss on the banquet in 2018, we tightened our belts and made some money on the banquet in 2019 from the raffle.

The differences in Revenue between 2018 and 2019 were from a drop in membership, a lower donation amount (a rudder was donated and sold in 2018), and an increase in banquet raffle sales. The biggest differences in Expenses were from lower food expenses for the Bigs/Littles picnic and for the ice cream social, less was spent on banquet raffle prizes, and more trophies were awarded with correspondingly higher cost.

If it weren't for the banquet raffle, astutely managed by Madeline Rayfuse, or a donation from Monte Whitefield of his swap meet sales in October, we would have taken a loss for the year. Also, one less membership renewal would have hurt, so if you haven't renewed yet, **please send in your 2020 dues with the Renewal Form later in the newsletter.**
