Well, Fleet 4 members did attend one NorCal race, i.e. the Camellia Cup, on Folsom lake. The fleet was represented at the Cam Cup, taking third place in the C22 division (Mike Rayfuse and Fleet 4 Captain Kevin Clancy crewing). Kind-of-a slow year. Weather and the lake conditions (spelled DROUGHT) were some of the reasons for a slow year. So did COVID and the DELTA variant.

However, the prognosticators at Folsom Lake Yacht Club seem to think 2022 will be a better year. "Look - the lake level is up". Well, if it comes up too high, it will only be drained to maintain flood reserve capacity.

THERE IS ONE UNIQUE RACE LEFT FOR THIS SEASON - the Annual Cup Boat Regatta held up in El Dorado Straits. This year's format made this a 3-race series, but there is still opportunity for some good fun. The principle behind the race is that you build the boat on site (no used, very fast, winning models from previous years) - DARN. The materials required are provided: 1 foam cup (hull), a 6" x 8" piece of sheet mylar (sail), all the straws and tape needed, and a few coins for ballast. Example pic below:

No Captain Report from Kevin Clancy. During general discussion:

- Kevin will try to locate the Fleet's digital projector, first contacting Roy Moore, then Laura-Ann Charlot.
- Also, Kevin will work with Rich Mason to reestablish the Fleet's Facebook page with current updates. Cross-links should be established between the website and Facebook.

Social Report from Madeline Rayfuse:

- Ice Cream Social on August 12th is canceled because of personal reasons for Madeline, and is rescheduled for Thursday September 9th, still at the Rayfuse home. Fleet 4 will provide the ice cream, and Folsom Lake Yacht Club is invited to come and provide the toppings.
- Annual Banquet on January 22, 2022 was suggested to research Cattlemen's Steakhouse in Rancho Cordova.

Cruising Report from Susan Patchett:

- Delta Cruise on July 9-11 was led by Roy Moore with Noreen, and attended by Jay Bernard, and Gary & Karen Preston.
- Union Valley Cruise scheduled for August 13-15 (Shooting Star Cruise) is dependent on enough water. Susan will research and report the decision in her newsletter article.
- Lake Camanche is the next cruise scheduled for September 10-11. This is also dependent on enough water, and Susan will check when the date gets closer.
- Halloween Cruise scheduled for October 30 was suggested to research Lake Natoma, usually with constant water level.

Treasurer Report from Gary Preston: Reviewed the budget from a handout, and he projects a net income of \$140-\$160 at year end. There is a balance of \$6,900 in the bank account.

Membership Report from Bill Martin: 20 members from 2020 have renewed for 2021. Plus 4 new members, and he is working with another possible new member.
