Sat-Mon, May 23-25: Memorial Day Weekend Cruise. Location: Folsom Lake.

Sat-Mon, October 10-12: Columbus Day Weekend/Fleet Week Cruise. Location: SF Bay.

Sat, November 7: Fleet 4 Awards Banquet. Location: TBD but probably Aviator's Restaurant. Date is tentative, and may move up or back by a week to avoid conflict with FLYC Banquet.

Two Week Summer Cruise: Locations proposed: San Juan/Gulf Islands, SF Bay/Delta, Santa Catalina Island Rendezvous (date fixed, July 3-19). A cruise to the San Juans or SF Bay/Delta would have flexible dates. The San Juans are best in July and August. An extended cruise in SF Bay and Delta could be in early October and coincide with the Fleet Week cruise. The extreme wind conditions typical of the Bay and Delta in mid-summer have calmed down by October, and it's really a gorgeous season for boating the Bay.
